PRESIDENT'S REPORT

I would like to personally thank all the members who came out for the spring workday on 5-21-16. We had about 40 dedicated members who showed up and got right to work building the new roof over the bench rest side of the range. They were able to set the post, build the frame work and start installing the tin on the roof.

Another crew worked on the safety light system, while yet another crew did general cleanup of the grounds and repairs to target backers. To get everything ready for the workday there was a lot of prep work done by Tony Miano, Tom and Bill Bridgewater, and myself.

We will need 3-4 young, strong members to move two bench tops to the shotgun area so we can glue them on the support bases. We can load them onto the gator to move them. Each top weighs about 250-300 lbs. If you can help call one of your board members so we can set up a date to do the work.

We were unable to do the trenching for the electrical work to the shooting stations or get onto the range to do required welding on the gong stands due to the wet conditions. Hopefully it will dry out enough in the near future that we can call a special workday to complete the work.

Work on the trailer park is proceeding slowly, however we hope to have it completed in a couple of months. The person doing the work is going to put the scrap lumber in piles so we can burn them in the fall.

We are now in full swing of the match season. If you would like to try your hand at shooting competitions, come out and have some fun. You'll meet a bunch of nice people.

We recently had someone try to break into the storage trailer by the pistol range and they broke into the two old buildings at the trailer park. I would like to ask all members when they are at the range to keep an eye on the buildings and if you see anything suspicious or any damage to any building to contact one of the board members.

Have a safe year and I'll see you at the range.

Range Improvements

In the past few months many of you have noticed several improvements being made at the range. Last year we poured the pad to enlarge the shooting bench area. This spring we started the building on the pad and got some of the roof on it. We will complete this project this fall during the range work day on 15 October. The project provides more room for shooters and helps get non-shooters back and in a safer position. Also during the spring range work day we started installing a warning system to let shooters know when it is safe to shoot and when it is not. Red lights and horns will be used to warn shooters that it is not safe to shoot and that someone is down range. We hope that these improvements make your shooting trip to the range safer and more enjoyable.

Range Safety

It is very important to have safety on your mind when at the range. If you see an unsafe act, be sure to say something to the shooter. Safety glasses and ear protection are required at all times while at the range. Accidents are not planned and will happen when you least expect them. Be Safe!
