Shotgun Usage

Shotguns are NOT to be used on the rifle portion of the range. Use only the designated shotgun area on the south end of the high-power range. There are two shooting benches in this area and an orange snow fence movable backer there. Shotgun shots to the black backers do a large amount of damage to the frames and backers.

Membership Cards

All members of the 67 Gun Club must have their current membership card on them while at the range. This is a Club policy that we need to follow. This is required even when your at the range alone, anyone could pull up to shoot and not see you down range and start shooting.
