NO STEEL TARGETS OR GROUND TARGETS ON THE HANDGUN RANGE

Clean-up Before You Leave

When you are done shooting at the range clean up before you leave. Toss trash into the trash cans, spent brass into the blue tubs and used targets removed from the backers. If you see a trash can getting full, take the time and empty it into the trash dumpster.

Shotgun Usage

Shotguns are <u>NOT</u> to be used on the rifle portion of the range. Use only the designated shotgun area on the south end of the high-power range. There are two shooting benches in this area and an orange snow fence movable backer there. Shotgun shots to the black backers do a large amount of damage to the frames and backers.

Dues Have Increased

Earlier this year a vote was held after several months of discussion of the rising cost of maintaining the range. In July the motion was made to raise the yearly dues to \$75 a year. We had sent several emails out notifying members of this upcoming vote and club officers spoke to as many members as they could about this subject. At the July meeting 6 club officers and 13 members in attendance voted 19-0 to raise the dues. \$75 is still the best bargain to use the range, that comes out to \$6.25 a month or about \$0.20 a day.
