From The Range Safety Officer

Another shooting season is about to begin and it's time to give some thought to range safety. Our club has an enviable safety record due to the cooperation of our members and we certainly need to continue in this vein. Each new member goes through our orientation and safety meeting prior to receiving their gate card. In addition to the regular concerns regarding keeping firearms unloaded when not on the firing line and muzzles pointed in a safe direction, a major safety concern involves going downrange to change targets. It's a 4-step procedure.

- Agreement among all shooters that it's time to go downrange.
- Firearms unloaded, magazines out and actions open. (included tubes on leverguns)
- Step back from the bench. No one should be seated at the bench while people are downrange.
- Turn on the warning light. It is to remain on until the last person is behind the benches.

These are simple steps that prevent accidents while people are down range. Add to this "No handling of Firearms while people are downrange" and we will continue to have a safe range. Safety is everyone's responsibility as we all suffer if there is a mishap.

Archery Range

Some Archery Range plans have been put on paper and discussions continue. We're waiting to get the parking lot expansion finished so we can get what's needed in there and get started. The parking lot is close to completion, we just need a few more nice weather days. We welcome all feedback on this project.
