Range Safety is #1

Our club has an enviable safety record due to the co-operation of our members and we certainly need to continue in this vein. Each new member goes through our orientation and safety meeting prior to receiving their gate card. In addition to the regular concerns regarding keeping firearms unloaded when not on the firing line and muzzles pointed in a safe direction, a major safety concern involves going downrange to change targets. It's a 4-step procedure.

- Agreement among all shooters that it's time to go downrange.
- Firearms unloaded, magazines out and actions open. (included tubes on lever-guns)
- Step back from the bench. No one should be seated at the bench while people are downrange.
- Turn on the warning light. It is to remain on until the last person is behind the benches.

These are simple steps that prevent accidents while people are down range. Add to this "No handling of Firearms while people are downrange" and we will continue to have a safe range. Safety is everyone's responsibility as we all suffer if there is a mishap.

Gate Problems?

If you experience problems with the gate, please contact Larry LaChance and let him know. If we catch problems early, we can get them repaired before they become big problems and we have to close the range.

As a reminder to not carry your gate keycard in your wallet. This practice can damage the internal parts of the card. It really sucks to drive all the way to the range to find out your card is broken.
